### PRESCHOOL

Stevenson-Carson Special Education Preschool 2019-20 School Year classes are Monday, Tuesday, Thursday, and Friday. There will be no preschool on Wednesdays. The 3/4 year-old class is from 9:20 a.m. - 11:20 a.m., the 4/5 year-old class is from 12:20 p.m. - 3:20 p.m. The first day of Preschool is August 30, 2019. NOTE: Preschool will follow the Stevenson Elementary School Calendar. There will be no preschool during conference week(s).

### CHILD SCREENINGS

Free child screenings for children aged 3-5 years for special education services will be offered to residents in the Stevenson-Carson School District on Wednesdays. These are for children who have not reached age appropriate milestones in skill development and who have not yet entered Kindergarten. Additional dates throughout the year will be scheduled on an as needed basis.

Children will be screened in hearing, vision, speech, cognitive, behavioral and motor development. Stevenson-Carson and ESD 112 personnel administer screenings for evaluations for developmental delays. Results are confidential and are discussed with parents at a meeting scheduled following the tests. Interested parents should call Kali Stump, at (509) 427-5672 to schedule a screening appointment.

### Registration

To be eligible for kindergarten a child must be five on or before August 31<sup>st</sup>. A birth certificate or proof of birth and a certificate of immunizations are required.

### PROHIBITION OF HARASSMENT, INTIMIDATION, AND BULLYING

The Stevenson-Carson School District is committed to a safe and civil educational environment for all students, employees, parents/legal guardians, volunteers and patrons that is free from harassment, intimidation, or bullying. In order to ensure respect and prevent harm, it is a violation of District policy for a student to be harassed, intimidated or bullied by others in the school community, at school sponsored events, or when such actions create a substantial disruption to the educational process.

Incident Reporting Forms may be used by students, families, or staff to report incidents of harassment, intimidation, or bullying. The complete harassment and bullying policy (Board Policy #3207, 3207P) and incident forms are available at any of the school building offices or online. The form may be filed anonymously, confidentially, or the student may choose to disclose his or her identity. ### COMPULSORY ATTENDANCE LAW

All parents in the State of Washington of any child 8 years of age and under 18 years of age shall cause such child to attend public schools and such child shall have the responsibility to attend full time when such school may be in session unless he/she qualifies as an exception under the law. Such exceptions include private and home school options, and other special circumstances. In an effort to encourage all students and their families to comply with the compulsory attendance law, new requirements have been added, which include notifications of parents of non-attendance, scheduling of conferences, and other steps to eliminate or reduce a student's absences. District truancy procedures are available at school offices, and attendance exceptions are listed in the Compulsory School Attendance and Admission law, Chapter 28A.225, available at the District Administration office or the public library.

### PARENTS' RIGHT OF ACCESS TO STUDENT RECORDS

Stevenson-Carson School District, in order to protect the privacy of parents and students, and to comply with the requirements of Section 438 of the General Privacy Act as amended, designates the following categories of personally identifiable information from student records as directory information: the student's name, photograph, address, telephone number, date and place of birth, dates of attendance, participation in officially-recognized activities and sports, weight and height of members of athletic teams, dates of attendance, diplomas and awards received, and the most recent previous school attended. It is the right of the parent of a student, or any student who has attained the age of 18, to refuse to permit the designation of any or all of the aforementioned categories of personally identifiable information with respect to that student as directory information. Any such student or parent must notify the school district of such refusal within ten (10) days of the publication of this notice. Such written notice should be addressed to Karen Douglass, Superintendent, Stevenson-Carson School District, at PO Box 850, Stevenson, WA 98648.

### ANNUAL PESTICIDE APPLICATION NOTIFICATION

The District complies with all legal requirements for recordkeeping regarding the application of pesticides to school property. Persons desiring to receive notification prior to application of a pesticide should contact the District Administration office and request to be placed on a pre-notification list. Appropriate signs shall be placed in the location of the application. Pre-notification is not required if the school grounds or facilities will not be occupied by students for two days following application of the pesticide (Board Policy #6895).

### TEACHER QUALIFICATION NOTICE

In an effort to keep parents informed of the qualifications of teachers, the reauthorization of the Elementary and Secondary Education Act (ESEA) allows parents to inquire at school whether their child(ren)'s teacher(s) have met state qualifications and certification requirements for the grade level and subject taught. Parents may inquire whether a teacher is under emergency or conditional certificate through which state qualifications were waived, and they may request information about undergraduate or graduate degrees the teacher holds, including

graduate certificates and additional degrees, and major(s) or area(s) of concentration. Parents can also ask about paraeducators working with your child in Reading, Writing, and/or Mathematics. We can tell you whether your child receives help from a paraeducator and whether he/she meets state qualifications and/or licensing requirements. Stevenson-Carson School District annually conducts a review of teacher assignments to assure that no teachers are assigned to areas for which they do not meet Washington State certification and/or endorsement requirements. Only on rare occasion does the District seek a waiver to certification. When this does occur, it is typically for a teacher who is within a few credits of completing the endorsement and is actively working on such completion.

### TRANSPORTATION

#### Parents and Guardians

For over 650 Stevenson-Carson School District students the school day begins and ends with a trip on a school bus. The greatest risk is not riding the bus, but approaching or leaving the bus. Before children go back to school or start school for the first time, it is essential that adults and children know traffic safety rules.

#### Bus Service Eligibility

School bus transportation is provided for students that live outside a one-radius mile from their school for all grade levels. Exceptions are made only when safety concerns are identified by the transportation department and guidelines of the Office of Superintendent of Public Instruction have been met.

#### Enroute to Bus Stop

We ask that parents and guardians review their child's walking route to the bus stop or school and advise about safety concerns. Please teach children basic common sense practices to make school bus transportation safer.

#### Be Prompt

Make sure your child gets to his/her assigned bus stop no earlier or later than 5 minutes prior to the scheduled bus stop time. (Traffic, rerouting and other issues may arise and the times and stops are subject to change.)

#### At the Bus Stop

Make sure your child does not approach the bus until the bus stops and the door opens for them. Ensure they know to wait for the driver to signal it is safe for them to cross the roadway, and when they need to cross. Students should never walk behind the school bus. If your child drops something near the bus they should wait and tell the driver before retrieving it.

#### Passenger Conduct

Students should ride the bus in a responsible, respectful and safe manner. If necessary, a student may be assigned a seat on the bus, just like in the classroom. If inappropriate behavior continues, parents/guardians will be contacted and asked to help the student modify their behavior. Safety is our top priority!

#### Driver Authority

School bus drivers have full authority over the passengers on the bus (School Board Policy #6605). Food (including gum) and drink are not allowed to be consumed on the bus (WAC 392-145-021). Items that do not fit in the student's backpack shall not be accepted onto the bus. This includes, but is not limited to; basketballs, large musical instruments, and skateboards. Prohibited items also include, but are not limited to; flammables, firearms, weapons, breakable containers, tobacco, vaping devices, alcohol, drugs and all other articles which could affect the safety of the school bus or its passengers. Animals, except service animals, are also prohibited.

#### Changing Stops

Bus Passes are required by elementary students who need to change their regular assigned stop.
