New Immunization Rules

WA State schools have changed the way they collect immunization records and comply with immunization rules. The new changes will take effect beginning with the 2020-21 school year.

➤ **All students**

- Must be up to date on immunizations **-or-**
 - Must be in conditional status **-or-**
 - Must have valid exemptions prior to the first day of classes even if school starts up virtually **-or-**
- *If your child is up to date on immunizations and has been enrolled in the district prior to August 1st, no action is necessary.*
- Effective August 1, 2020, these three major changes will go into effect:
- All new immunization records from students need to be medically verified.
 - The definition of “conditional status” has been clarified.
 - The Tdap vaccine requirement for 6th graders has been changed to a 7th grade requirement.
 - There will no longer be a 30 day grace period to provide immunization records.
