## **New Immunization Rules**

WA State schools have changed the way they collect immunization records and comply with immunization rules. The new changes will take effect beginning with the 2020-21 school year.

## > All students

- o Must be up to date on immunizations -or-
- Must be in conditional status -or-
- Must have valid exemptions prior to the first day of classes even if school starts up virtually -or-
- If your child is up to date on immunizations and has been enrolled in the district prior to August 1<sup>st</sup>, no action is necessary.
- ➤ Effective August 1, 2020, these three major changes will go into effect:
  - All new immunization records from students need to be medically verified.
  - o The definition of "conditional status" has been clarified.
  - The Tdap vaccine requirement for 6th graders has been changed to a 7th grade requirement.
  - There will no longer be a 30 day grace period to provide immunization records.
